

Shooting Star Farm



Organic plant starts for your home garden. Please note, *indeterminate* varieties grow and bear fruit over a longer period of time and typically require tall support and significant space. *Determinate* varieties have a more limited fruit set and are often shorter or more compact, so they can be grown more easily in containers than indeterminate varieties.

Cherry	Sakura	Medium-large shiny red cherry with sweet tomato flavor. Firm but not hard. Early and long harvest season. Compact and prolific plant.	I	Yes, with tall support	
Cherry	Chocolate Sprinkles	Sweet cherry with unique coloring: red with brilliant green streaks. Tall plants with thick stalks. Crack resistant fruit. An ever-bearing plant for months of harvesting!	I		
Cherry	Black Cherry	Cherry with large, purple fruit and well-rounded flavor much like an heirloom.	I		
Cherry	Sunrise Bumble Bee	Beautiful combination of yellow and red inside and out. Sweet and tangy flavor. Great for snacking and salads. Bushy plant.	I	Probably, with tall support	
Cherry	Sungold	Deep yellow-orange when ripe. Amazing sweetness and thin skin. Plentiful harvest. Plants may be quite large.	I

Heirloom	Tazmanian Chocolate	Dwarf plant. Burgundy slicer with abundant flavor. Well-suited for containers; it is tidy, short, and only needs a standard tomato cage. 4-6 oz fruit.	D	Yes	
Heirloom	Pink Tiger Boar	Sweet juicy deep pink fruits with contrasting red and green stripes within. Mid-sized fruits, strong plants. 2-4 oz fruit.	I		
Heirloom	Rose de Berne	Mid-sized sweet pink slicer. Round fruits with meaty flesh perfect for slicing. Soft skinned, but not overly fragile and holds up well against cracking. 4-8 oz fruit.	I		
Hybrid	Chef's Choice Bicolor	Large flattened yellow beefsteak fruits with beautiful pinkish-red stripes. Sweet flavor like that of similar heirlooms, but earlier maturity and more uniform fruits that hold up all season. 7-8 oz fruit.	I		
Heirloom	Pruden's Purple	Early Brandywine type. Large dark pink fruits with crimson flesh, flattened and smooth (except for some shoulder ribbing). Fruits resist cracking. Medium-tall, potato-leaf plants. Large, up to 1lb. fruit.	I		
Hybrid	Damsel	Globe-shaped fruits with beautiful, pink skin and excellent flavor. Similar in flavor to other pink heirlooms, such as Brandywine, but better disease resistance. 8-12 oz fruit.	I	Compact plant, so possibly, with support.	
Heirloom	Valencia	Sunny orange fruits with full tomato flavor. Round and smooth, meaty interior, few seeds. 8-10 oz fruit.	I		

Type	Variety	Description	Indeterminate/ Determinate	Good for containers?	
Heirloom	Green Zebra	Produces many green/yellow variegated fruits with a unique tangy sweetness. Ripe when fruit turns golden, contrasting with the green stripes. 3-4 oz fruit.	I		
Heirloom	Evergreen	Mild, delicious flavor and medium to large size make these solid beefsteak fruit good for slicing and very enjoyable to eat.	I		
Heirloom	Black	Compact plants bear plenty of rich, mahogany-brown tomatoes. Delicious blend of sugar and acid and a distinctive, complex flavor. Some folks say this variety is one of the best-tasting black tomatoes and prefer it also for its nice, medium size. Russian heirloom. 4 oz fruit.	I		
Paste	Pony Express	Blocky oval red paste variety. Early harvest, large sets that ripen together. 4 oz fruit.	D	Yes, with support	
Paste	Granadero	Prolific plum. Produces high yields of uniform, attractive, bright red tomatoes with very good flavor. Thick-walled fruit; ideal for fresh tomato sauces, salsas, and salads. High disease resistance. 4-5 oz fruit.	I		
Red Slicer	Galahad	Early beefsteak. Excellent flavor and impressive disease resistance. The round fruits can be harvested with green shoulders and ripened red in storage, or ripened on the vine. Vigorous plants. 7-12 oz fruit.	D	Yes

Red Slicer	Tasti-Lee	Abundant crops of slightly flattened bright red fruits that keep well long after picking. Plants provide shade to ripening fruit, protecting from sunscald. Classic red tomato. 6-9 oz fruit.	D		
Red Slicer	Rutgers	Long considered an outstanding slicing, cooking and canning tomato. Medium-sized mostly uniform and unblemished deep oblate fruits with a rich red interior, old-time flavor, and pleasing texture. Open pollinated. 4-6 oz fruit.	I		
Large Red Slicer	Caiman	Large disease resistant fruit with full, rich flavor. Bright red with attractive creased shoulders reminiscent of an heirloom. Grow in clusters of 4-6 on vigorous plants and hold well on the vine. Good fruit set even in hot weather. 12 oz fruit.	I		
Basil	Emily	Compact version of the classic Genovese type with a bushy habit. Great for small spaces.		Yes	
Bell Peppers	X3R Knight	King Arthur type with better disease resistance and a more compact, open plant. A large, early, green-to-red pepper. Big, blocky, thick-walled bell pepper turns red early. Fruity and sweet.

Bell Peppers	Flavorburst	Vibrant golden yellow. Initial color is lime green, turning to golden yellow. Excellent sweet flavor. Medium-large fruits are mostly 3-lobed and slightly elongated.			
Jalepeno	Jedi	High-yielding, continuous set type. Our largest jalapeño offering, Jedi's fruits avg. 4–4 1/2" and are slow to check (show small cracks in skin). The large plant produces over a long harvest window, especially in regions with a long growing season. Our jalapeño variety with the highest potential yield. High resistance to bacterial leaf spot races 1-3			
Bell Peppers	Iko Iko	Our largest jalapeño offering, Jedi's fruits avg. 4–4 1/2" and are slow to check (show small cracks in skin). Eggplant	Aninna	Spineless, purple-striped Italian type. Glossy, variegated eggplant with attractive teardrop shape. Avg. 7-8" long by 3-4" diameter. Bright green calyx. No spines.
